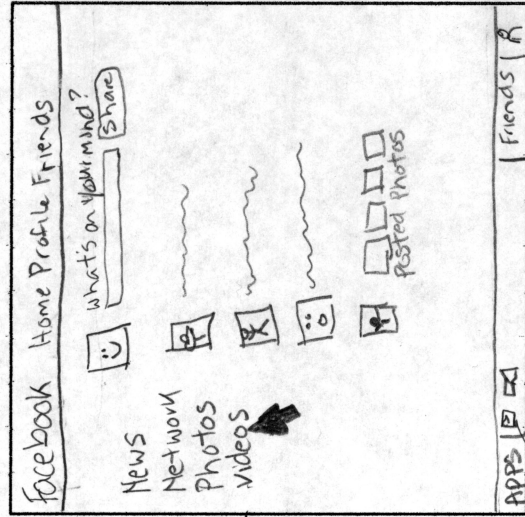

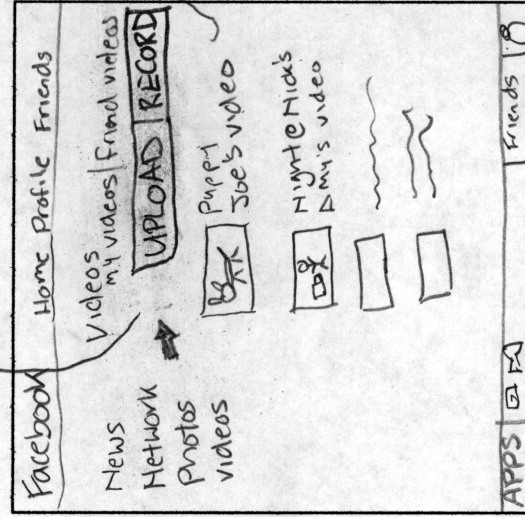
Uploading a video to Facebook

Friends videos displayed under video options



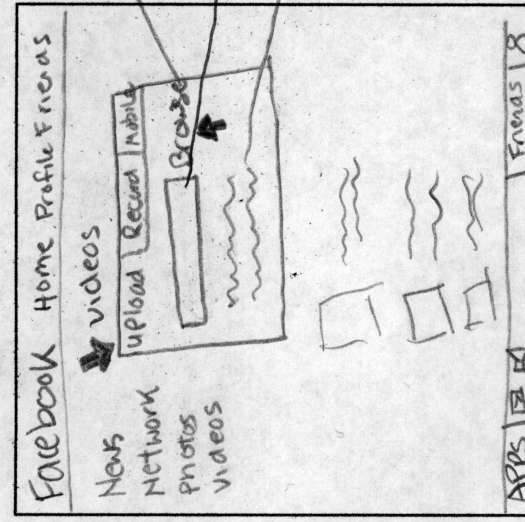

Both video links go to central video page



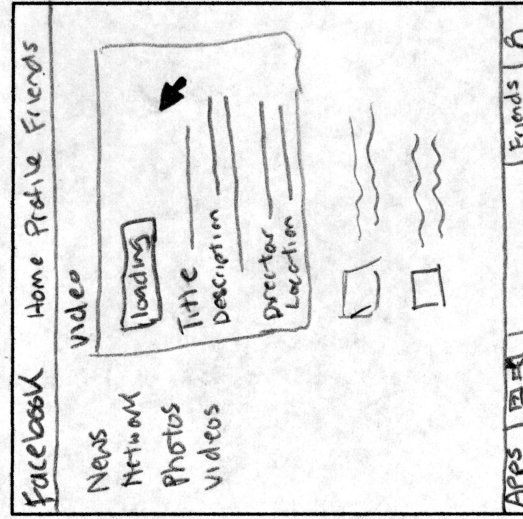
Upload Page

The main video page will display recent videos added by your friends. At the top of the page users can select if they want to upload, record or send a mobile video - or just browse friend videos.

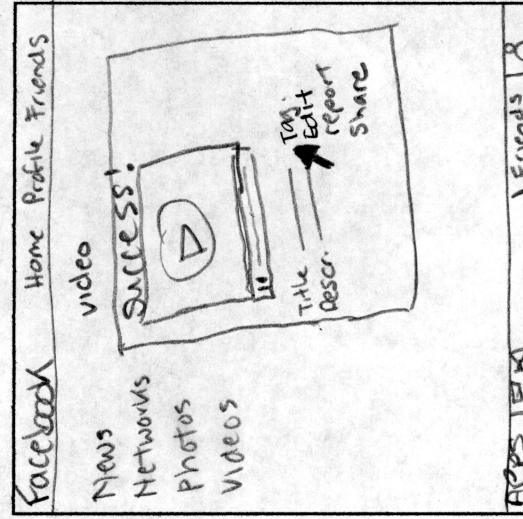

Loading Page

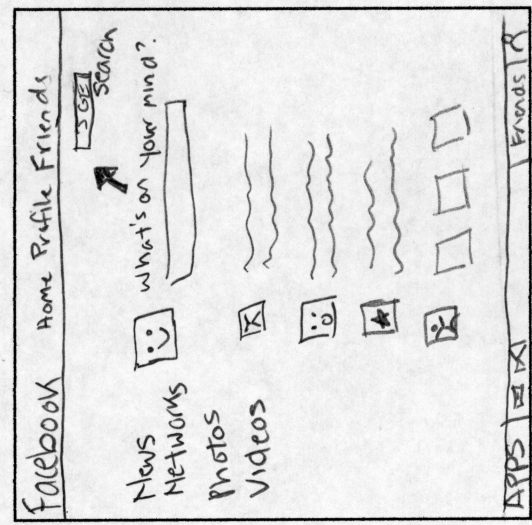
Write loading your video meta data can be added - Such as a title, description, location, director name, keywords



Tag friends

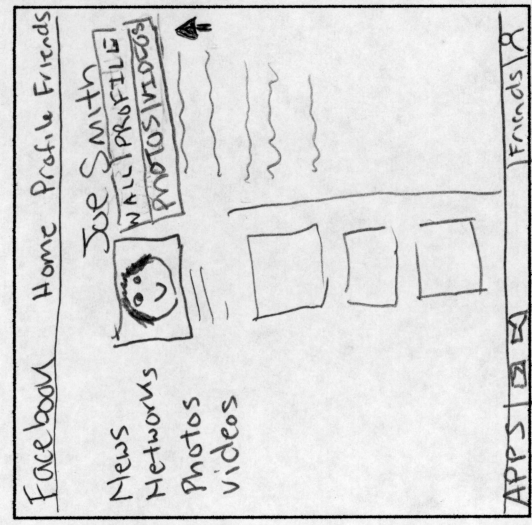
Once uploaded, users can tag their friends in the video. During video play, the user can pause the video. Click tag friend; select portion of screen, select friend's name. The same process can be followed to add comments to specific frames of the video.

Locating a friend's (Joe's) video



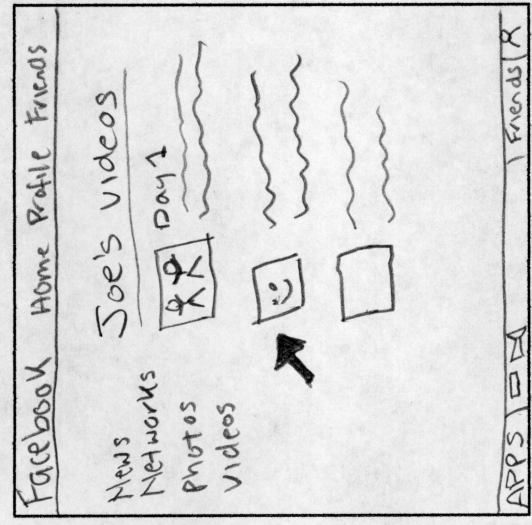
Facebook home page

From the main page, users can type in the name of the friend they are trying to find.



Joe's profile

Since Joe has uploaded a video, a video tab will automatically be added to the top of the user's profile.



Joe's Video Page

The individual user's video page will display a chronological list of the videos they have uploaded.
