

RPI Spring Team Tournament Rules

Date: April 7th

Location: McNeil Room Student Union, RPI

Machine: 2 StepMania “cabinets” consisting of both DDR and ITG 1

Registration:

Teams must be registered or checked in by the end of the registration period on the day of the tournament. No qualifiers are required for any division. *Pre-register by contacting an officer by e-mail or in person.* The cost for each player is \$5 per person or \$20 for a full team. A college ID must be presented at registration and/or check-in. Individual competitors will be assigned to a team based upon their preference for division. Club officers themselves may fill an incomplete team.

Times:

Registration and check-in: **11:30AM – 12:00PM** (noon)

Standard/Heavy Doubles: **12:00PM-2PM**

Standard Singles: **12PM-2PM**

Heavy Singles: **12PM-2PM**

Battle Mode: **2PM-4PM** (close)

All times listed are tentative, and are subject to change based upon how long the previous divisions last. No division will start before the listed time. Players are responsible for being present for their division at the appointed time. Any absent player will be given five (5) minutes from the time they are called to play to arrive at the machine for their turn, after which they will be disqualified from the respective division. The Tournament will be promptly stopped by 4 P.M. At that time, cumulative Dance Points (DP) will be added for all completed rounds, and used to determine a winner.

For all divisions the following applies:

The player will be presented with a choice of songs, where they will choose one set (three songs) to play. The total accumulated DP will be added to their team’s pool. Participants will play two sets in their division.

Once a player picks a song, they may no longer choose the same song for the remainder of the division. At the end of each song, DP will be calculated for both players using the following formula:

Perfect	Great	Good	Boo	Miss	O.K
+2 DP	+1 DP	0 DP	-4 DP	-8 DP	+6 DP

Modifiers/Other rules:

We will provide a table for use as a bar for only one song per set. You must declare before starting that set, and your decision is final.

Singles competitions will be played on ignition-style soft pads, while doubles will be played on Cobalt Fluxes. Battle mode will be played on either type of pad, as chosen by the participant before their set.

Any unnecessary distractions while players are competing (including, but not limited to, clapping, talking, and snapping) will not be tolerated and are grounds for disqualification.

Prizes:

Prizes will be distributed based on the prize pool which is based on how many people register. 30% of the prize pool will be given to the club while the remaining 70% will be distributed accordingly to the winners in the following fashion: **1st: 40%; 2nd: 20%; 3rd: 10%**. The RPI DDR Club reserves the right to change these percentages based upon the number of teams entered.
